

Poster Making Contest!

A poster making contest is a fun way to bring attention to the Day of Pink and also to get those creative juices flowing!

Steps:

1. Get Permission

- Make sure you speak with the proper individuals such as your principle or boss to ensure that you can use their office or other facilities for distributing prizes to the winner(s).

2. Get Volunteers

- Ask friends, family, co-workers and other members of the community for help with the organization of the game.

3. Advertise

- Use eye-catching and colourful flyers and put them up and hand them out in popular areas. Be sure to include the date, place and cause of the game.
- If the game is being held at a school it would be effective to have it advertised on the intercom or morning/afternoon announcements

4. The Contest:

- Students will compete to make the most creative, decorative, eye-catching and informative poster.
- The posters will be advertisements for the upcoming Day of Pink.

5. Choose a Winner

- Have the organizers of the contest choose who wins.

Tips:

- Be sure to tell the students what the Day of Pink means and why they wear the pink shirts. This way they will have a better understanding of what their posters should be about.
- The contest should be held a few weeks before the Day of Pink. That way all of the posters can be posted around the school/office well before the day.
- For this game, a few winners should be chosen. For example, there could be a winner for the most artistic poster, the most eye-catching, the most original, the most informative, etc. That way people will not feel left out if they do not have artistic or other abilities.
- Remember that sometimes students graffiti posters, so be sure to put them in a place where they can still be noticed but not touched such as high up on a wall.
